## Thesis > Manage Boxes

1. Upload the Header Image box
2. Make sure the Header Image Box is active (has a white background and is checked)
3. Save boxes just to be sure

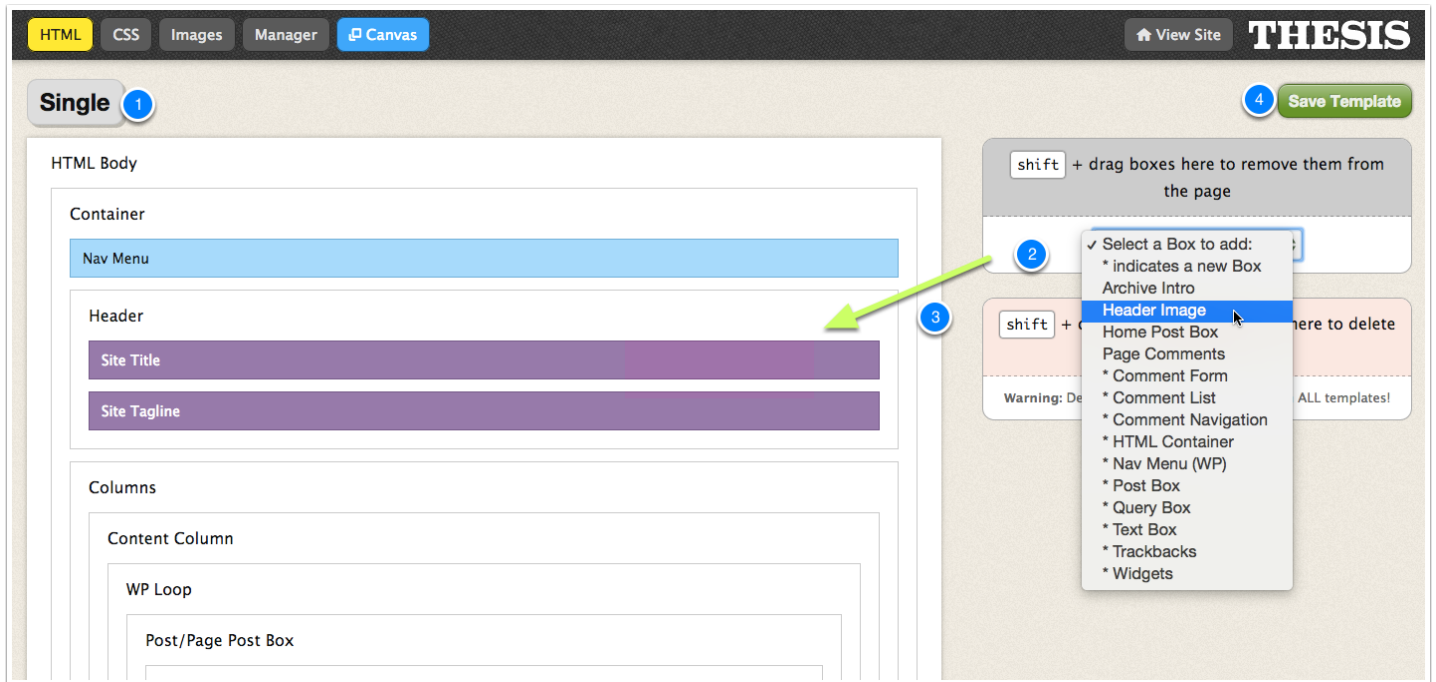

## Skin Editor

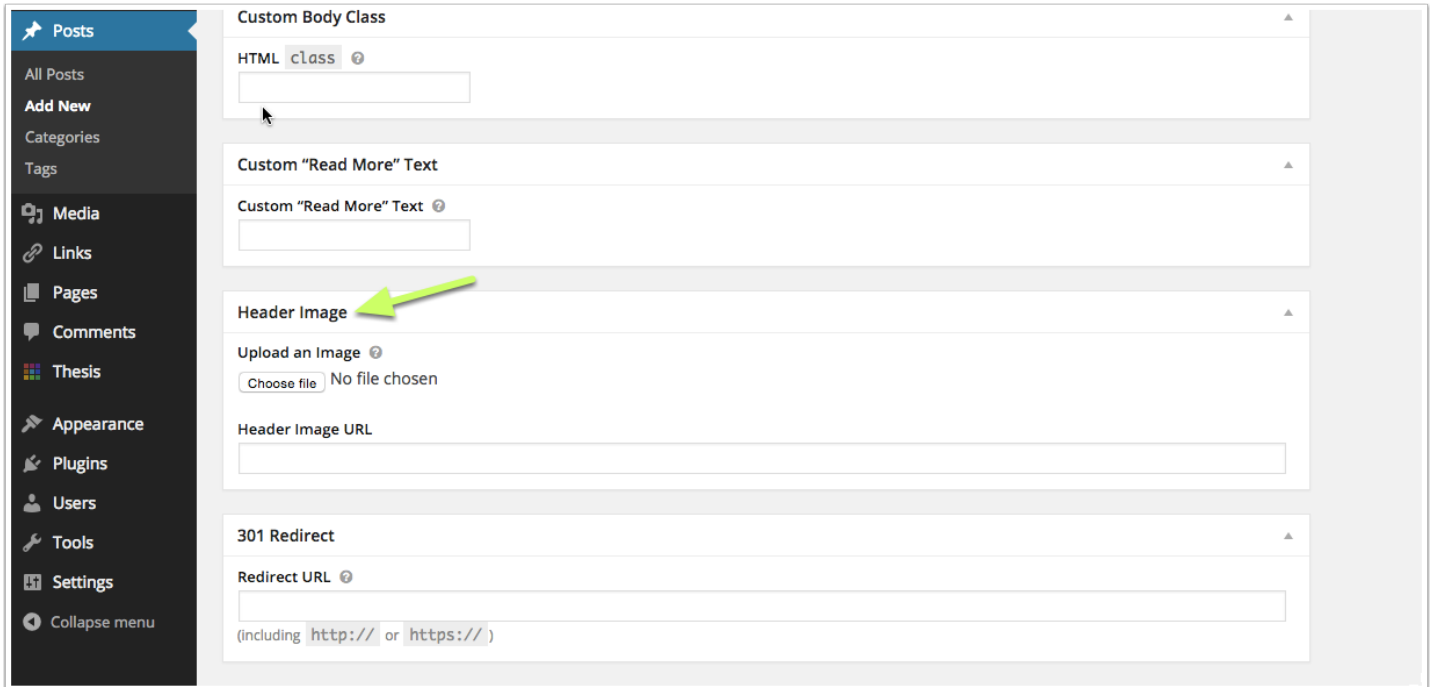
1. Choose the template to add the Header Image box to
